Rebecca L. Withrow obtained her BA in Anthropology from Guilford College in 1995, her MS in Community Counseling from Western Carolina University in 2003, and her Ph.D. in Counseling and Counselor Education from the University of North Carolina at Greensboro in 2006. She become interested in the issue of twin loss when a close family member lost an identical twin to a hereditary form of cancer, and the family began a search for a grief counselor who could help.
